

Do I Have to Attend Every Service?

Each Christian must answer the above question for himself by examining at least four passages in the New Testament.

The first passage is Hebrews 10:25, "Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together..." This verse carries with it the power of an order that makes the act of assembling with other Christians a command not to be disobeyed. In fact, the very next verse says, "For if we sin willfully..." implying that to not assemble is a sin.


The second passage is Matthew 5: 13-16, ..."Let your light so shine before men..." Regular worship attendance on our part, although only one aspect of our Christian example, has much more influence on those around us than our most persuasive arguments to convince them of the truths of the Gospel.

The third passage is Matthew 6:33, "But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness..." This means simply that at every decision point the Christian is obligated by his commitment to God to choose the path that seeks the kingdom of God FIRST.

The fourth passage is Ephesians 5:16, "Redeeming the time, because the days are evil." There is only so much time during the

week (168 hours), and Paul indicates that we should take advantage of every opportunity to serve God and be a better Christian.

The conclusion is this: Every Christian should develop the ATTITUDE that he will attend every service because 1. he wants to obey God; 2. he wants to be a good example to family and friends; 3. his priorities are to serve God first; and 4. attending worship services is the best possible use of his time because it helps direct his life toward Tony W. Boyd
