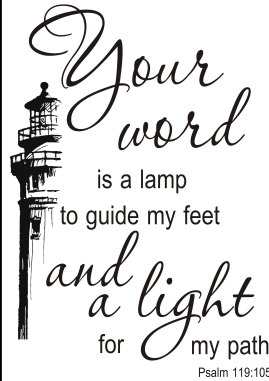

A WELL-KNOWN TRIO

A man can starve his soul as readily as he can starve his body. There are some who don't believe that. They think they are so strong, so intelligent and so self-sufficient that they can make their own way in the world, alone.

Such people need to be reminded of the words which the apostle Paul wrote to his friends in Corinth, "So faith, hope, love abide, these three, but the greatest of these is love." (1 Corinthians 13:13).

Here we have man's three greatest necessities. Try to live without them and you will have to find something else which looks like them. If you discard faith and hope and love, you must discover some counterfeits.

You can't get by in life without reliance upon something. For reliance lies at the heart of all faith. For the apostle Paul that reliance was in Christ. He could write, "The life which I now live in flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God" (Galatians 2:20). That faith did not prevent sorrow nor pain nor injury, but it did prevent murmuring, complaining, resentment and revenge. It was faith which enabled him to live in the midst of troubles. If you don't have that kind of faith you will have to find something which looks like it.

You can't get by in life without hope. When hope dies men are ready for suicide. Christianity offers "a living hope." There is something to look forward to. Without hope life is a sham. With hope we have an anchor which gives stability to our lives. Calvin saw a connection between faith and hope and called hope, "perseverance in faith." Whatever you call it, it's a necessity. Life without hope is no life at all.

And then there is the necessity of love. It is like breathing. Breathing is not a duty; it is a necessity. We breathe or we suffocate. Loving is the key to life, said Jesus. Love God; love your fellow man. A life without love - forget it. There's no such thing. Babies die without love, and so do we. We must receive love, and we must give love, or we will wither on the vine.

So when all is said and done there are three things which remain: faith, hope and love.
