

According to the Associated Press, Chuck Wall, a human relations instructor at Bakersfield College in California, was watching the news one day when a cliché from a broadcaster stuck in his mind: "Another random act of senseless violence." Wall got an idea. He gave an unusual assignment to his students. They were to do something out of the ordinary to help someone and then write an essay about it. The idea took hold. The bumper stickers were slapped on all 113 county patrol cars. It was trumpeted from the pulpits, in schools, and in professional associations. After seeing the success of the idea, Chuck Wall commented, "I had no idea it would erupt like it has. I had no idea our community was in such need of something positive." In this negative and dark world, we each can do acts of kindness to bring some light.
