

Things I Cannot Defend or Explain

Often I am asked to defend what we believe and practice. And I believe that I can usually give a Biblical, sensible, and understandable answer, but I must confess that there are some things that we "practice" that I would not attempt to defend. Neither can I explain the reasoning behind these "practices."

I CANNOT EXPLAIN:

*Why some people can find time to be active in the community, and yet not have time to do some work of the church

*Why some can spend \$20 or more for some recreation and fun and then place only \$5 to \$10 in the collection plate on Sunday

*Why the newspaper gets read every day, and the TV gets turned on every day, but the Bible does not get read every day

*Why we can talk to our friends about all kinds of subjects ... for hours ...yet we claim we can't talk to them about the Gospel

*Why some parents don't bring their children to Wednesday night classes because they don't want to keep them out late, but the same parents do not hesitate to keep the children up past bedtime for a party or company

*Why someone can claim that Jesus is the Lord of his life and yet

choose to be absent from the worship of the Lord

*Why any member of the church should have to be reminded, much less begged, to be faithful in attendance

*Why about 10 percent of the people in the church do about 90 percent of the work (and in the average church, 10 percent of the members give about 50 percent of the money)

*Why some people are habitually tardy for classes and worship - the most important "appointments" of their entire week
