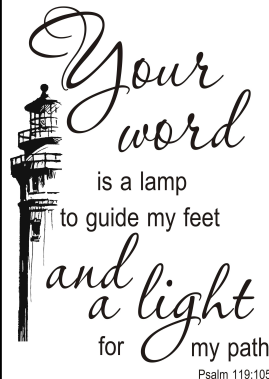

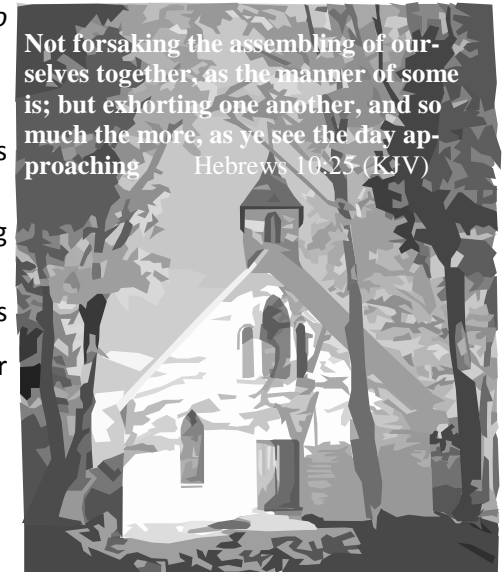
**JESUS ATTENDED THE EVENING SERVICE**
