

As one grows older, a major struggle of life is one's outlook - whether we chose to be optimistic or pessimistic. We all want to have a positive outlook on the future, but that is difficult for many. It becomes easier when we keep God in the picture. Solomon viewed life without God and determined, Vanity of vanities, saith the preacher; all is vanity (Ecclesiastes 12:8). abominable, and murderers, and whoremonaers, and sorcerers, and idolaters, and all liars, shall have their part in the lake which burneth with fire and brimstone: which is the second death (Revelation 21:8). A life without hope is the only view that the world has. Each person needs God in their life, and He must be kept in ours. Remember that God rules the world, we do not know what the future holds, but we know **who** holds the future. God is at work on the side of good in the lives of those who love and obey Him: If ye keep my commandments, ye shall abide in my love; even as I have kept my Father's commandments, and abide in his love (John 15:10). And so all things are possible, and we can look for good things to occur: And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to his purpose (Romans 8:28).

The best is yet to be, and God's obedient children are on their way to heaven. These two things make for a bright and glorious future. And God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes; and there shall be no more death, neither sorrow, nor crying, neither shall there be any more pain; for the former things are passed away. And he that sat upon the throne said. Behold. I make all things new, And he said unto me, Write: for these words are true and faithful. And he said unto me, It is done. I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the end. I will give unto him that is athirst of the fountain of the water of life

freely. He that overcometh shall inherit all things; and I will be his God, and he shall be my son (Revelation 21: 4-7).
