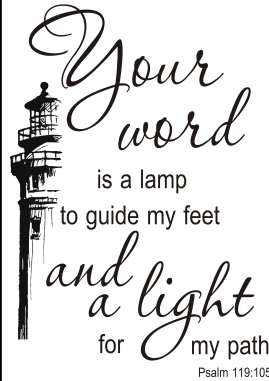

Wednesday Night Ladies Christmas Party December 6 at the home of Trish Baldwin. More information to follow

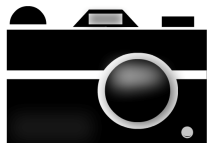

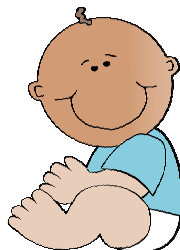
